NATIONAL BOARD RESULTS IN RADIOGRAPHY: Analysis of Program Effectiveness Data for Regional Accreditation Compliance:
Five Years of data was collected and analyzed as required by CCAC to measure outcome data relating to the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) National Certification Examination. “CCAC has a very high pass rate average!”

“National average pass rate for past five (5) years for all graduates who sat for the ARRT RADIOGRAPHY BOARD EXAM: = 88%”

ADVANCED STANDING PROGRAM PASS RATES for REPEAT ATTEMPTS on National Board Examination:

CCAC is one of few programs that offers assistance to graduates from College Based Radiologic Technology Programs who have a difficult time passing the national certification examination. CCAC is recognized by the ARRT as an ADVANCED STANDING PLACEMENT PROGRAM. Graduates must complete a series of requirements and courses to become eligible to sit for the national boards again after three failed attempts.

CCAC’s Advanced Standing Placement Program pass rate on the ARRT Radiography national boards is very high with a “95%” pass rate average.

The above data chart is for all graduates scores on the national certification examination for the last five (5) years. The national certification examination is provided by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) in Radiography.

Employment placement data:

Graduate data is collected every twelve (12) months after graduation yearly.

Placement rate average for Full-Time Employment for the last five (5) years = 84%
